The study included a detailed examination of sex trafficking dynamics, a review of current laws in Virginia, analysis of available statewide data, and consultation with a wide array of experts in the field, to include survivors, victim service providers, law enforcement, prosecutors, advocates, medical professionals, and various federal, state and local agencies/organizations.
