Staff was requested to conduct a study regarding the decriminalization of possession of small amounts of personal use marijuana. Staff reviewed marijuana laws and current practices both in Virginia and across the country with a focus on the decriminalization of marijuana. Note that staff's review did <u>not</u> include such topics as legalization of marijuana, medical marijuana, or the health effects of marijuana.
