IV. CHILD PROSTITUTION (HB 1991)

Stewart Petoe, Director of Legal Affairs, Virginia State Crime Commission*The Crime Commission was requested to review the possibility of decriminalizing child prostitution, with the understanding that children engaged in prostitution should be handled as children in need of services, rather than going through the criminal justice system. The bill also creates an affirmative defense for prostitution if force or deception was involved.

V. EXPUNGEMENT OF FORCED PROSTITUTION CONVICTIONS (HB 1541/SB 1273)
