

The following is a summary of bills that were endorsed by JCOTS following the 2024 General Assembly Session. Links are to the original language of the bill which may not reflect the language that was voted on by the Commission.

Bills recommended by JCOTS

A bill that was *recommended* was presented to the Commission with the understanding that changes were no longer being integrated or if they were, it was to provide consistency with new or existing legislation.

<u>SB 164</u> - Virginia Consumer Protection Act; prohibited practices, artificial intelligence disclosure.

<u>SB 487</u> - Directs JCOTS, in consultation with relevant stakeholders, to conduct an analysis of the use of artificial intelligence by public bodies in the Commonwealth.

Bills recommended in concept

A bill that was recommended in concept was presented to the Commission as a draft that was still actively being modified.

HB 747 - Artificial Intelligence Developer Act; established, civil penalty.

<u>HB 697</u> - Synthetic media; use in furtherance of crimes involving fraud, etc., report.

Bills recommended with considerations

A bill that was *recommended with considerations* was presented to the Commission in its final form and received feedback from the Commission that would have to be considered and responded to, by the patron, before it could be recommended.

<u>SB 252</u> - Consumer Data Protection Act; controller privacy notice, consumer consent. ("Cookie" opt-out)

SB 359 - Consumer Data Protection Act; social media platforms; addictive feed.

Other Actions

The following two bills were sent to the Blockchain Subcommittee: <u>SB 339</u> & <u>SB 439</u>. A motion was passed to create a Blockchain Advisory Committee within JCOTS beginning in 2025.
